#### FACILITY

The Greensboro Aquatics Center is a 50 meter pool which can be broken into
two short course venues with a separate diving well. This competition will use
a 10 lane short course competition venue with continuous warm-up and cool
down lanes available throughout the meet. The pool depth is 9'-10' at the
start and turn ends and 4" lane lines will be used to reduce turbulence. The
lane width is 7'. A Colorado Timing System 6 with a Daktronics Pro-Star LED
Video Scoreboard Display will display results simultaneously. Starting platforms
are Colorado Competition deck anchored platforms. The competition course
has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such
certification is on file with USA Swimming.

No outside Food or Drink will be permitted. There is a spectator seating area with a capacity of 1850 persons. <u>Spectators are not allowed on the deck at any time.</u> The 650 bleacher seats on deck are reserved for swimmers only.

VENUE SHOPSKAST-A-WAY Swim wear is located near the main entrance. Food and drink<br/>may be purchased from various Food Carts located throughout the venue

PARKINGParking will be \$5.00 per day (or a discounted rate for entire the week-end)<br/>with re-entry allowed. Parking for Coaches and Officials will be provided.

# MEET FORMATThere are five (5) sessions in the meet including 10 & Under Timed Finals and<br/>11-12, 13-14 and Open Prelim/Finals. Friday will be a timed finals session.<br/>Saturday and Sunday Evening Finals will be as follows:

- 11 year olds will have one (1) heat of finals for each event.
- 12 year olds will have one (1) heat of finals for each event.
- 13 year old 100 and 50 Events two (2) heats of finals (B and A in that order); 200 and over events will have one (1) heat of finals.
- 14 year old 100 and 50 Events two (2) heats of finals (B and A in that order); 200 and over events will have one (1) heat of finals.
- Senior events will have two (2) heats of finals (B an A in that order).
- A & B finals will score points. Two pools will be used during the morning session with one pool being used in the evening at finals.

SAFETYThe NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to<br/>closely supervise their swimmers at all times. NO running or horseplay will be<br/>tolerated.

RACING STARTS	Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by an USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by an USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
RULES	This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is strongly discouraged.
ELIGIBILITY	All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. to participate. Swimmers without current proof of membership will not swim. <b>THERE WILL</b> <b>BE NO ON DECK REGISTRATION.</b>
SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES	Star Aquatics welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit Star Aquatics' ability to accommodate all requests.
ENTRIES	Please email entries using Hy-Tek Team Manager for entries. List all swimmers' ages as of <b>December 6, 2013</b> . Entries may be sent via email and must include the following:
	<ol> <li>A Hy-Tek compatible entry file</li> <li>Team entry report</li> <li>Financial report</li> <li>List of all coaches who will be in attendance to confirm current credentials. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet.</li> </ol>
ENTRY LIMITATIONS	11 & Over swimmers are limited to a maximum of 3 individual events per day and 8 individual events throughout the weekend.
	10 & Under swimmers are limited to a maximum of 4 individual events per day and 10 individual events throughout the weekend.

Relays are not included in the limit. Meet Management reserves the right to limit and/or eliminate events to allow the meet to run in the allotted time.
 ENTRY VERIFICATION An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.
 ENTRY DEADLINES The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries 10:00 pm Tuesday, November 26<sup>th</sup>. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee. There may be on-deck entries but only in open lanes and at the discretion of the meet director. Double fees will apply to all late entries and must be paid before entry can be done on deck.

SEEDI	<b>EEDING</b> The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmer will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order. There will be no course conversion for this meet. The 400 IM and 500 Free will be deck seeded slowest to fastest and may be limited to the top 3 heats to stay within the allotted time.	
CHEC	K-IN	<ul> <li>A positive check-in, located at clerk of course, will be required for the following events: <ul> <li>400 IM</li> <li>500 Free</li> </ul> </li> <li>Check in for events will be as stated in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Swimmers that fail to check in will be scratched from the event and not seeded. In the positive check-in events, a swimmer who has checked in, been seeded, and fails to complete in said event, shall be barred from his/her next individual event. Swimmers will have to provide their own lap counters. Swimmers may have to provide their own timers.</li> </ul>

RESULTS	Live results will be posted on STAR Aquatics' website. At the conclusion of the meet results will be sent to each team via email attachment.
COACHES	All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of certification/registration and shall prominently display their registration cards at all times while on deck. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches meetings.
OFFICIALS/TIMERS/ VOLUNTEERS	There will be a need for officials. Star Aquatics welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet or sign in once you arrive at the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be required to show proof of certification/registration. Officials shall prominently display their registration cards at all times while on deck. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers. Official briefings will be held in the hospitality area at the date and time listed in the Meet Schedule and Deadlines table.
HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS	There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials. Refreshments will be available at the concession stand carts.
WARM-UP	In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down in the diving well. There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.
WAIVER/RELEASE	As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all of the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and North Carolina Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines, and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet.
